Pistol may be shot with a 2-hand hold. Tiebreaker target will be shot on a card. Prizes and awards will be made after last relay.

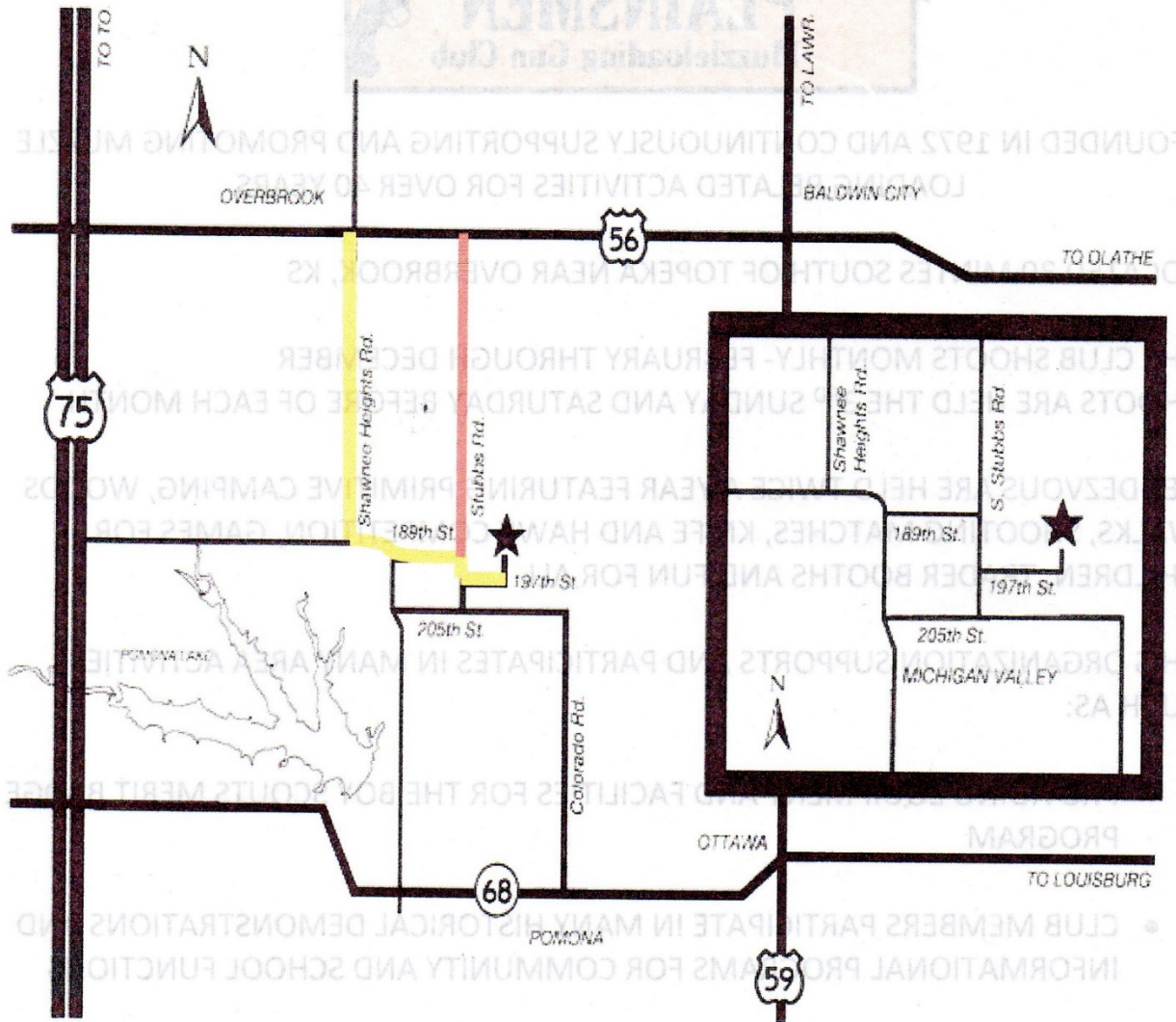
Round Ball only. The shotgun awards will be after the shotgun match on Saturday.

# First Santa Fe Trails Plainsmen Overbrook, KS



Drive south on Maple St (the main street that goes through downtown). Outside of the city limits it is Shawnee Heights Road. The road will curve left and then right; at the second curve turn left onto 186<sup>th</sup> Street. Continue to Stubbs Road, turn right. Continue to 197<sup>th</sup>, turn left. The drive to the range is about  $\frac{3}{4}$  of a mile down the road; turn left into the drive.

Alternate route: Go south on Stubbs Road to 197<sup>th</sup>, turn left. The drive to the range is about  $\frac{3}{4}$  of a miles down the road; turn left into the drive.

**Look for signs pointing the way to the range.**
